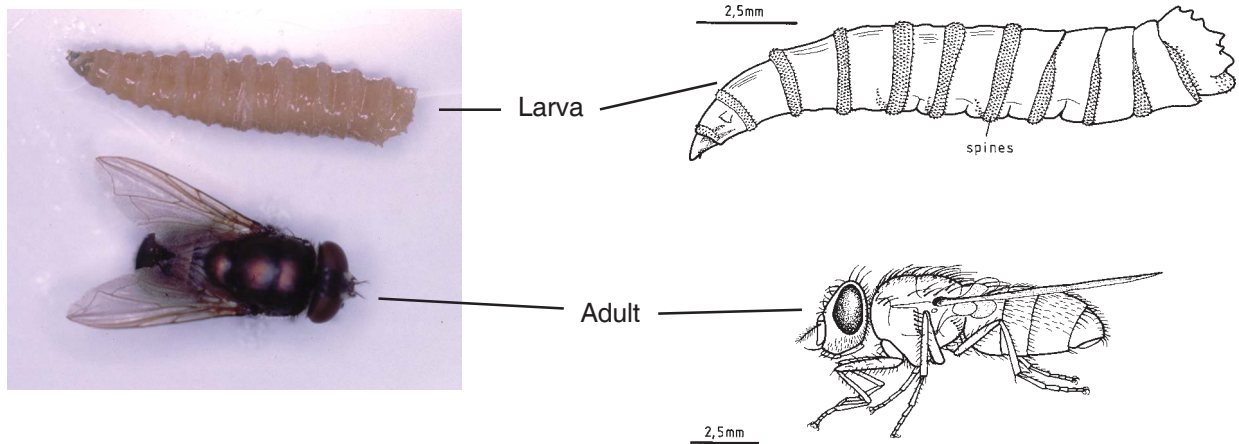


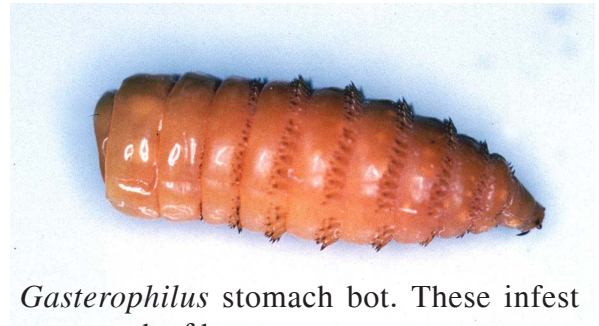
# Flies - 3



*Lucilia* adults and larvae. Adults known as greenbottles or blowfly. The larvae invade flesh of host, causing myiasis. In sheep this is known as blowfly strike. The adult *Lucilia* has sponging mouthparts and causes no direct harm.

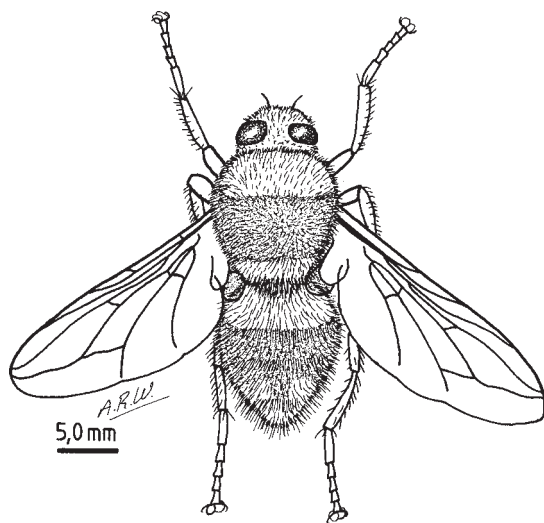


*Oestrus ovis* nasal bots, at top a second stage larva, below a mature third stage larva. They infest noses of sheep.



*Gasterophilus* stomach bot. These infest stomach of horses.

These types of myiasis larvae are easy to diagnose to level of genus because they are highly characteristic of host species and part of body infested.



*Hypoderma* warble fly. Adult on left, mature stage three larvae on right. The adults have no mouthparts and cause no harm. Adults of *Oestrus* and *Gasterophilus* are similar.
